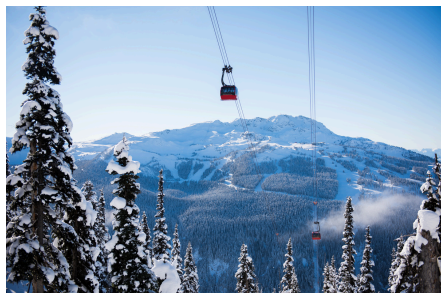


## Breakfast in Whistler

Every good ski day starts with a hearty breakfast - here's a guide to some of the best places to eat breakfast in Whistler, as recommended by our team.



Below is a selection of our favourites; there are lots of other options throughout the resort - from grab & go stands to decadent brunches. Just give us a shout if you'd like any more recommendations.

### Provisions

Located on the Village Stroll, one minute's walk from the Crystal Lodge, you'll also walk past Provisions on your way to the Whistler Village ski lifts if staying at the Delta Whistler Village Suites or the Summit Lodge Boutique Hotel.

This trendy café serves fantastic barista coffee, freshly baked goods, brioche breakfast rolls, toasts and more. Be sure to try the Cinnamon Sugar Morning Bun – a croissant/muffin combination showered in cinnamon sugar goodness! There's plenty of comfy indoor seating or you can order to take away.

### Moguls Coffee House

Located in the Village Square off the Village Stroll with a few indoor and outdoor tables, Moguls has a real focus on local produce and zero waste. Everything here is designed to go, so if you're in a hurry you'll get quick service to get on your way. Great coffee, tasty breakfast wraps and bagels and sweet treats to go alongside.

### Lift Coffee Company

A locally owned coffee shop right next to the Whistler Village Gondola, serving excellent coffee and breakfast sandwiches - or be tempted by the delicious range of cookies. The perfect spot for grabbing a coffee for the gondola ride, or take your time and enjoy the heated patio.

### Portobello

Visit Portobello for an elevated yet relaxed breakfast scene in the luxurious Fairmont Chateau Whistler. A variety of breakfast bowls, sandwiches and burritos are on the menu here, or treat yourself to a true Canadian feast of Buttermilk Fried Chicken waffles. There's ample indoor seating here or you can simply get a coffee and pastry to go.

### Purebread

On hand to satisfy all your bakery needs and desires. Whether it's a freshly baked loaf to take back to your suite and enjoy with the family, or tasty grab & go pastries and sandwiches, Purebread has you covered. Located towards the north of the village by the Whistler Olympic Plaza this is a handy spot if you're staying at the Summit Lodge Boutique Hotel or Delta Whistler Village Suites.

### Rockit Coffee

A funky retro style coffee shop in the heart of Creekside Village featuring smoothies, breakfast wraps and variety of baked goods including cookies, breads and cruffins – excellent fuel for your day on the slopes.

### Fresh Tracks

Hit the slopes first! Access the Whistler Village gondola between 7:15am and 8a.m. for a mountain-sized breakfast buffet at the Roundhouse Lodge, then enjoy the slopes all to yourself before the mountain opens to the public.



#### Need to know:

**The Breakfast Burrito:** fill up for the morning with this Whistler favourite. At Portobello, try the Maple Brisket Burrito loaded with smoked beef brisket, scrambled egg, potatoes, smoked cheddar.

**Biscuits for breakfast?** In Canada, 'biscuits' are common breakfast fayre, however they're much more like a scone than a British biscuit. Best adorned with eggs, bacon, cheese, maple syrup - anything goes really!
